PROGRAM COMMITMENT

The RISE Urban Leadership Fellows Program commitments are:

- Attendance and participation at four (4) all-day forums. Each forum is three (3) full days (Friday- Sunday) and are held once a quarter.
- Attendance and participation at three (3) required technical sessions. Each technical session is three hours long and scheduled to take place between each forum.
- Devoting up to five (5) hours each month to additional training, cohort meetings, and individual work with program faculty.
- Collaboratively developing and leading a Community Action Project that builds throughout the program year, putting new knowledge and skills into action.
- Development of a Personal & Professional Excellence Plan.

REQUIRED DOCUMENT UPLOADS

- A recent copy of your résumé or curriculum vitae (PDF or Word .doc or .docx format only)
- A professional biography, 300 words maximum. (PDF or Word .doc or .docx format only)
- A quality, high-resolution headshot. The photo does not need to be taken by a professional photographer, but should be professional in appearance. (.jpg, .jpeg, or .png format only, with a <u>minimum resolution of 300dpi and a maximum file size of 1MB</u>)
- 4. **Two (2) letters of recommendation**: Applicants are required to provide recommendations from people familiar with your leadership capacity and efforts in the urban community. **The recommendation letters will be uploaded on application portal.**
